








What is the input of the mature in the conversion of those who are attending?

What is the input of others in the congregation, e.g. new converts? Who has the most impact?












In what ways does the church engage with the "community"? What are the different roles of mature, discipled, new converts or potential converts? Who has most impact?








The number who progress in discipleship each year depends on:


How many wish to be discipled each year




Supply and demand control the flow





The number who can be discipled each year can depend on




The limited time and ability of mature Limited opportunity to be involved




Discipleship limited by opportunity (A), then by supply (B)

Discipleship limited by supply (B) only. Opportunity limit (A) not reached.


# Discipleship Supply, Demand & Opportunity
